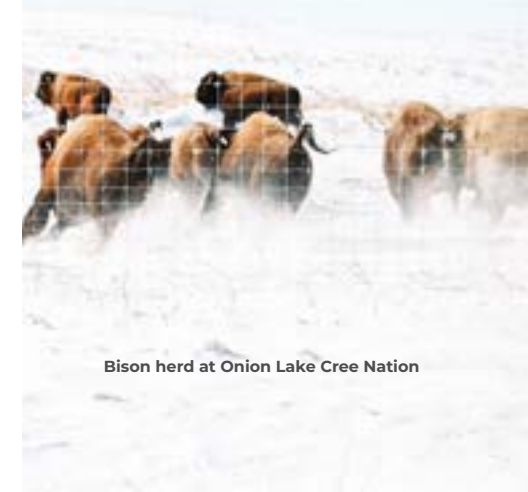

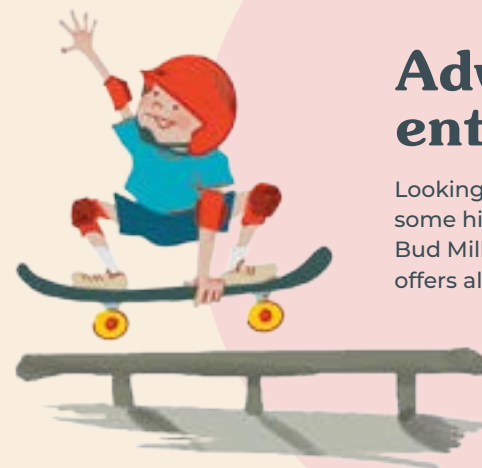

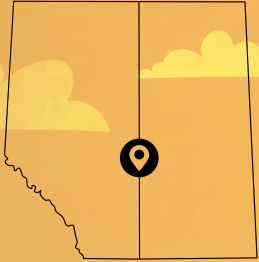

The stunning prairie lands and fertile soil were what first drew farming settlers to this region in Canada's early days. Today, agriculture remains one of Lloydminster's biggest industries.

History & Culture

In 1900,

English settler Isaac Barr envisioned Western Canada as a "utopia" and inspired 2,600 colonists to join him on a transatlantic journey to a better life; but the trip was far from ideal.

After months in an overcrowded troop carrier, the group landed in New Brunswick, then travelled by rail to Saskatoon. From there, they trekked another 275 km on foot and by wagon through harsh terrain before finally settling in what would someday become known as Lloydminster.

Leadership eventually shifted to Reverend George Lloyd, after whom the settlement was renamed in 1903. Originally part of the Northwest Territories, Lloydminster was split in two when Alberta and Saskatchewan officially became provinces in 1905, putting the provincial border right down Main Street!

In 1929, a devastating fire destroyed over 50 downtown buildings. The city was then rebuilt and officially united as Canada's first (and only!) Border City in 1930.

Did you know?

We're proud to be located in the heart of Treaty 6 Territory, a historic agreement that stretches from the Rocky Mountains across the prairies of Saskatchewan. Treaty 6 encompasses 17 First Nations Peoples, including the Dene Suliné, Cree, Métis, Nakota Sioux, and Saulteaux.

We honour these Peoples as the past, present, and future stewards of this land and celebrate their resilience, strength, and culture. Despite facing generations of systemic adversity, Indigenous culture remains steadfast, vibrant, and deeply woven into the fabric of our region.

Ways to Learn:

- Visit Lloydminster Museum + Archives for exhibits highlighting Indigenous culture and history.
- Visit a regional park and connect with nature.
- Pay homage to Indigenous memorial sites and take time to reflect.
- Celebrate National Indigenous Peoples Day and join in community events.
- Enroll in the University of Alberta's free Indigenous Canada course online at ualberta.ca for an accessible introduction to Indigenous history and culture.
- Attend a Powwow – a powerful way to experience Indigenous traditions, music, and dance. See the Powwow Trail on page 16

Powwow Etiquette

Powwows are open to newcomers; everyone is welcome! Here are some tips to experience them with respect to the culture.

1. Be On Time

Check the event schedule and arrive early to ensure you don't miss important ceremonies like the Grand Entry or Opening Prayer.

2. Listen to the Master of Ceremonies

The Emcee will guide the event, explaining each performance and its cultural significance. When requested, stand respectfully or remove your hat as a sign of honour.

3. Be Respectful

Many elements of a powwow are sacred. The Grand Entry and Opening Prayer mark the start of the event, with an Elder leading the prayer, the drum, symbolizing the heartbeat of **Mother Earth** (or **the Creator**, depending on local traditions), is at the centre of it all.

4. Ask Before Taking Photos

Some ceremonies and regalia are deeply personal and sacred. Always ask permission before taking photos of participants or performances.

5. Bring Tobacco

Offering tobacco to an Elder or dancer is a sign of tremendous respect in the Indigenous community. It can be offered to them when you ask them to share their knowledge.

6. Hands Off

Dancers' regalia is sacred and often handmade with deep personal meaning. Avoid touching it without permission.

7. Shop & Explore

Most powwows feature vendors selling unique handcrafted items and food trucks offering delicious treats like fry bread and bannock tacos. Enjoy the experience and support local artisans!

What's in the Boreal Forest?

Did you know that Canada is home to 25% of the Earth's wetlands, temperate rainforests and boreal forests? The Boreal Zone covers northern Alberta and Saskatchewan, which is vital to thousands of indigenous birds, fish, and mammals. Our regional and provincial parks are protected by laws to preserve as much natural habitat as possible. Find out which nearby regional and provincial parks you can visit on page 87.

Great Blue Heron

You may have seen this big blue creature standing along the shore of any lake or wetland across the prairies. The Great Blue Heron is the largest heron in Canada; adults grow to stand over 1 meter tall!



Western Tiger Salamander

These are the only salamanders native to Saskatchewan, and are also the biggest in north America! Salamanders are amphibians, but unlike frogs, they are nocturnal and do not make any noise, so they can be difficult to find! Salamanders live near ponds and wetlands, and during winter they hibernate deep underground.



Woodland Caribou

You've seen the face of the woodland caribou on our 25 cent coin! Did you know both males and females grow antlers? They are currently at risk of becoming endangered, and you can help environmental scientists work to protect them. If you see caribou in the wild, you can report your sightings at Biodiversity.sk.ca.



Common Yarrow Plant

Indigenous peoples of North America have used yarrow leaves for wounds, burns, and insect bites as well as using its dried leaves for medicinal teas to soothe colds, fevers, headaches, and much more. Yarrow leaves can also be burned in smudges to repel mosquitoes.



Fun Indigenous Fact

In Plains Cree tradition, it has been said that some stories should not be told until there is snow on the ground. If you break this rule, you risk a visit from Osikiyâwis (Salamander), who will crawl into your blankets while you sleep.

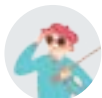

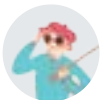

Regional Parks

There are over 100 regional parks in Saskatchewan, and all of them are managed by local government and volunteer boards. Some parks are located next to towns, and some are deep in rural areas surrounded by the forest. Each park is unique and has different amenities to offer, ranging from 18-hole golf courses with restaurants to fishing and tent camping. Most of the funds for maintaining these parks comes from visitors like you – so come discover more with your family and friends!

Sandy Beach

Fifteen minutes north of Lloydminster

Silver Lake

10 minutes north of Maidstone
Golf course, clubhouse restaurant, firepit picnic areas, two large family areas and camp sites.

Brightsand Lake

27 km Northeast of St. Walburg
Forest camp sites, private beach areas, restaurant, playground, golf, fishing, and nature trails.

Makwa Lake Provincial Park

This massive stretch of land connects five lakes situated near Makwa Sahgaiehan First Nation. Find multiple sandy beaches, campgrounds, and service centres.

Atton's Lake

45 minutes Southwest of Maidstone
Service facilities, concessions, playgrounds, beaches, golf course & clubhouse, ball diamonds, horse shoe pits, and a pickle ball court with equipment provided.

Suffern Lake Regional Park

Located an hour South of Lloydminster, Suffern Lake is a charming little lake named after Jack Suffern, a local Metis man who stocked the lake with fish and planted evergreen trees to restore nearby forestry land during his life. There's more than meets the eye here; the park offers 9 Bunnock courts as well as scenic sand dunes within walking distance.
