Acknowledgement

2026 is the 150th Anniversary of Treaty 6, which was signed on August 23, 1876, at Fort Carlton in Saskatchewan. The total area of the Treaty covers 50 First Nations across Western Alberta, through Saskatchewan, and into Manitoba.

We acknowledge that we are on Treaty 6 Territory and the Homeland of the First Nation people. Our relations are bound by our ancestors through Treaty to steward this land and seek mutual benefit for as long as the grass grows, the sun shines, and the river flows. We pay our respect to the First Nation ancestors of this place and honour Elders and Survivors as we work to bring awareness to Indian Residential Schools, the Sixties Scoop, and Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women, Girls, and Two-Spirited Peoples. To acknowledge this territory and its keepers on their traditional terms is to act in reciprocity so that truth may be upheld, and reconciliation made possible.

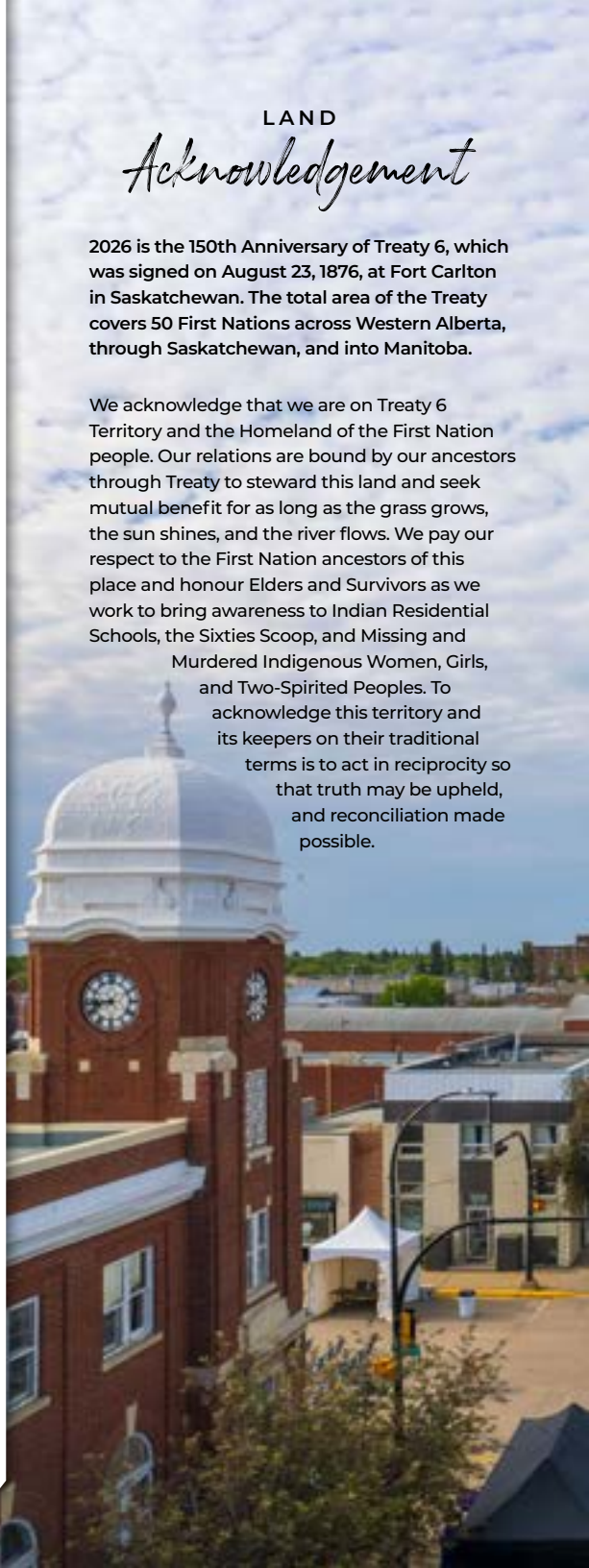

Onion Lake Cree Nation is a vibrant Cree community of over 7,000 members, located just 30 minutes north of the City of Lloydminster. Deeply rooted in Plains Cree culture, our Nation proudly shares its history, language, and traditions with visitors from near and far.

Throughout the year, we host many cultural and sporting events, including Cultural and Sports Days during the July long weekend, a Winter Carnival, and hockey tournaments throughout the winter months. We have also reintroduced a bison herd to help restore traditional teachings and pass on the cultural significance of the buffalo to our younger generations.

Our two signature events are the July 1st celebrations, featuring professional chuckwagon and Indian relay races, and our annual Pow Wow held in mid-July, welcoming dancers and visitors from across Turtle Island. We invite you to experience the strength, culture, and hospitality of Onion Lake Cree Nation.

Lloydminster Public Library

The library is a hub for curiosity, creativity, and community connection.



Lloydminster RCMP & Emergency Services

The Lloydminster RCMP and local Emergency Services work to keep our community safe and informed. While 911 is for emergencies only, non-emergency numbers are available for reporting issues or getting assistance. They also offer safety programs, community workshops, and resources to help residents stay prepared, from crime prevention tips to fire safety advice. Long before Lloydminster became the vibrant border city it is today, this region drew settlers with the promise of wide-open skies, rich soil, and the potential of untapped natural resources. Those first pioneers built their lives on farmland and opportunity. Today, more than 120 years later, agriculture and the oil & gas industry remain as major staples of the city's economy.

The city services a trade area of approximately 189,000 people and multiple industry resources. Agriculture & Farming

Lloydminster's first roots of community establishment were brought together by pioneering farmers over 150 years ago. Today, local farms are connected to the Archer Daniels Midland (ADM) processing facility located right here in town. Wheat, barley, and canola crops are the long-standing pillars of Lloydminster's landscape, tirelessly maintained by the hard-working families who support the backbone of our local economy.

Beyond crops, the region is home to multigenerational family farms, cattle operations, emerging ag-innovators, and modern sustainable practices, all contributing to a thriving industry that feeds communities near and far.

Indigenous Experiences



📍 Poundmaker Cree Nation

Long before the cities and towns of today were built, archeological findings show us that this land was home to Indigenous peoples for over 10,000 years. For the Indigenous peoples of Treaty 6 Territory, these lands have provided food, shelter, deep spiritual connections, and rich cultural traditions passed down through countless generations.

With the arrival of settlers in the 19th century, the land and people of Treaty 6 endured rapid change; yet the history, strength, resilience, and influence of Indigenous communities remain an essential part of Lloydminster's story, woven into its land, culture, and identity.

The prairies, rivers, and skies connect us all and serve as a reminder that we are all Treaty people.

POWWOW ETIQUETTE: QUICK TIPS

Powwows are full of colour, music, and community. While there are sacred moments, the events are warm and welcoming and a great way to experience Indigenous culture!

Respect the Drum & Dance

- The drum is sacred - do not step onto the dance floor unless invited by the emcee.
- You can ask drummers before or after their performance if it's okay to take photos.
- Some songs or ceremonies are sacred; the emcee will announce when filming or photography isn't allowed.

Listen & Learn

- The emcee shares stories about the dances, songs, and traditions, it's a great way to learn while enjoying the event.
- Stand back and observe during ceremonies; pause conversation when songs or speeches are happening.

Dress & Comfort

- Wear comfortable shoes and clothing, outdoor powwows may have uneven ground, although most locations have an arbour.
- Bring sun protection or layers for changing weather.

Food & Vendors

- Take this as an opportunity to enjoy traditional meals! Bannock burgers are always a great idea.
- Support artisans by browsing and purchasing crafts or jewellery.

Children & Pets

- Keep children close and guide them to respect ceremonies.
- Pets are generally not permitted near ceremonial areas.

Move & Enjoy

- You're welcome to move around and explore the powwow, and join other attendees for intertribal – an opportunity for everyone to dance together!
- Intertribal dance is a part of the event where dancers from all different nations, communities, and dance styles are welcome to join in. It's not restricted to a single tribe or specific dance category - anyone attending can participate, regardless of their background or experience.
- Keep an open mind and enjoy the music, stories, and community spirit!

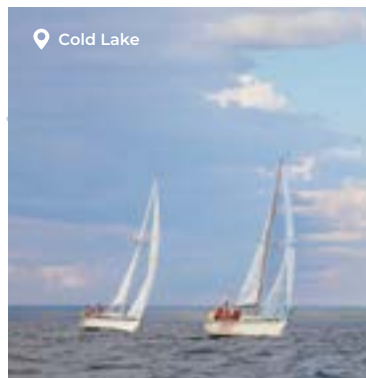

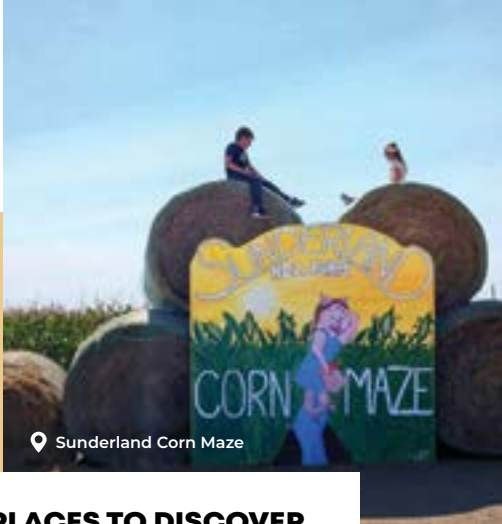
